## 1. Manchester United (South-east Asia) Supporters' Club

**Hangout:** Devil's Bar, Orchard Parade Hotel. **Members:** 6,500. **Membership fee:** From \$68 per annum. **Website:** [www.manutdsea.com](http://www.manutdsea.com) **Quirks:** For the ultimate indoor viewing experience, how about three giant screens, 12 television monitors and stadium-effect surround sound amid thunderous cheers from Man United fans? Drinks are 3-for-1 during Happy Hours until 9pm.

## 2. Singapore Liverpool Fan Club

**Hangout:** Liverpool Club House, Maxwell Road, behind former Traffic Police HQ. **Members:** 2,700. **Membership fee:** \$20 per annum (one-time \$30 registration fee). Below 12 years old — free. **Website:** [www.liverpoolfanclub.org.sg](http://www.liverpoolfanclub.org.sg) **Quirks:** Shirts soaked in perspiration, beer flowing, throats screaming, sitting knees up, big screen, big speakers — this is Premiership passion at its Singapore best, open air, on a basketball court.

## 3. Newcastle Supporters' Club Singapore

**Hangout:** Shamus O'Donnell's Irish Pub, Tras Street **Members:** 1,500 **Membership:** Free. **Website:** [www.nufcsingapore.com](http://www.nufcsingapore.com) **Quirks:** How about some VIP treatment from the pub? It will open specially for Newcastle fans if there is a live telecast on Sundays. For \$20, you also get three bottles of Newcastle Brown Ale, official sponsor of the football team.

## 4. Leeds United Supporters Club Singapore

**Hangout:** Lock, Stock and Barrel Pub, Seah Street **Members:** 160 **Membership:** \$60 per annum for adults, \$20 for overseas fans and fans below 18 years old. **Website:** [www.luscs.org](http://www.luscs.org) **Quirks:** Rowdy but friendly atmosphere permeates, as Leeds fans will teach their cheers and songs so that everyone will sing along during games.

## 5. Singapore Spurs Supporters Club

**Hangout:** Sportzballz, Seah Street **Members:** 175 **Membership:** For adults — \$30 one-time registration fee, \$20 per annum. For juniors under 12 — \$5 one-time registration fee, \$10 per annum. **Website:** [www.spurs-sg.org](http://www.spurs-sg.org) **Quirks:** Inside the memorabilia-filled walls, there is an extra incentive when Spurs play Leeds: fans from both teams will compete for the loudest cheers along Seah Street.

## 6. Singapore Everton Supporters Club

**Hangout:** Beach Bar, Robertson Quay Hotel **Members:** 60 **Membership:** \$15 last season, may be revised this season. **Website:** [www.evertonfc.org.sg](http://www.evertonfc.org.sg) **Quirks:** Laid-back viewing at its finest — watch football on a giant projection screen, with beach chairs to rest your legs on, in a pub that lies right beside the Singapore River.

## 7. Singapore Southampton FC Supporters Club

**Hangout:** Shidong Bar, Club Street **Members:** 70 **Membership:** \$18 for 18 years old and above, \$5 for those below 18 years old. **Website:** [www.singasaints.com](http://www.singasaints.com) **Quirks:** If you do not mind the distraction, live music performances inside the bar provide a welcome relief from the frenetic pace of live telecasts in the television outdoors.

## 8. Blackburn Rovers Singapore Supporters' Community

**Hangout:** Various pubs **Members:** 95 **Membership:** Free **Website:** [brfcsingapore.tripod.com](http://brfcsingapore.tripod.com) **Quirks:** Bar-hopping with a twist as the Blackburn fans prefer not to stay in one location.
